"The police should be allowed to 'stop' a person and detain him briefly for questioning upon suspicion that he may be connected with criminal activity Upon suspicion that the person may be armed, the police should have the power to 'frisk' him for weapons If the 'stop...

Police Conduct During a Stop passenger is armed, the "frisk" may be extended to the vehicle This "frisk" is a protective search and item, the officer may look inside the object and briefly examine the contents 4 An officer may use only the amount of non-deadly force that is reasonably necessary to effect a ...

### **In the Indiana Supreme Court**

Unless police have reasonable suspicion that a subject is armed and dangerous, they may generally conduct a pat-down for officer safety only with the subject's voluntary consent Here, Defendant asked to step out of his truck during a traffic stop, and police made their permission conditional on a pat-down
