Olea europaea - Olive Tree Family - Oleaceae • Grows in Mediterranean climates, USDA Hardiness zones 9-11 • Evergreen tree growing from 8-30 feet Average fruit producing life is 25-40 years but can be much longer • Requires well-drained soil, regular watering and full sun

Olive trees account for 70% of fruit production in Palestine and contribute around 14% to the Palestinian economy 93% of the olive harvest is used for olive oil production while the rest is used for olive soap, table olives and pickles Much of the olive production is for local consumption with a small amount of olives being exported

Fertilizing Olive Trees - UCCE Sonoma

It is difficult to really starve an olive tree for nutrients to such an extent that production becomes limited, unless there is a clear deficiency Even in serpentine soils that are excessively high in magnesium, olive trees do comparatively better than other orchard crops, but these soils are rare
